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1 The AUTOSAR Associate Partner [Light] Cross Reference

The rights to the Scope of Associate Partner [Light] which the Associate Partner [Light] may use for the purpose of exploitation after its waiver declared in clause 4.1 of the Associate Partner [Light] Agreement shall result from this document “AUTOSAR Associate Partner [Light] Cross Reference”. With this AUTOSAR Associate Partner [Light] Cross Reference the Associate Partner [Light] shall not be granted any rights beyond section 4 of the Associate Partner [Light] Agreement.

2 Exploitation

- 2.1 Selected share of released AUTOSAR Work which licenses the Associate Partner [Light] may use for the purpose of exploitation after its waiver declared in clause 4.1 of the Associate Partner [Light] Agreement:

After the Associated Partner [Light] declared its waiver in clause 4.1 of the Associate Partner [Light] Agreement, its granted rights of use are restricted to a selected share of the released AUTOSAR Work related to particular use cases (“**Use Case(s)**”) and the Associate Partner [Light] may use the rights granted to it only for that particular Use Cases.

The AUTOSAR Work is made available for download on the AUTOSAR website with each release.

- 2.2 Use Cases

The particular Use Cases are defined in this section 2.2 and also include per Use Case a list of the related selected share of the released AUTOSAR Work.

- 2.2.1. Use Case “Bus-System Compatible and Interoperable Products”

The purpose of the Use Case “Bus-System Compatible and Interoperable Products” is to promote further dissemination of AUTOSAR through deeper and more widespread support of Associated Partners [Light] by offering products that are interoperable with AUTOSAR systems and compatible with AUTOSAR bus protocols and related features.

Within the scope of Use Case “Bus-System Compatible and Interoperable Products”, due to its waiver declared in clause 4.1 of the Associate Partner [Light] Agreement, the Associated Partner [Light] remains permitted to market and sell products that are interoperable with AUTOSAR based systems and compatible to AUTOSAR bus protocols and related features.

For Use Case “Bus-System Compatible and Interoperable Products”, the Associated Partner [Light] remains permitted after its waiver declared in clause 4.1 of the Associate Partner [Light] Agreement to use the selected share of released AUTOSAR Work listed in Table 1: AUTOSAR Specifications for Use Case “Bus-System Compatible and Interoperable Products” in all available versions of AUTOSAR releases made available for download on the AUTOSAR website.
